They are currently a Michigan State University, USA, where they have had the opportunity to explore th cutting-edge facilities at the MSU Food Processing and Innovation Centre. In additio to this, they also visited a water treatment plant, gaining valuable insights into wate management practices. This exchange of knowledge and experiences wi undoubtedly enhance their expertise and benefit their academic community back a DBSKKV Dapoli.
Activity 2:	The faculty and students from the College of Fisheries in Ratnagiri, part of DBSKKY Dapoli, are currently immersed in a transformative international training program a Chulalongkorn University in Thailand, organized by NAHEP IDP. Their educationa journey has led them to explore a wide array of aquatic activities, including visits t diverse locations such as snake-skin gourami farming at Sukanya Farm, frog farmin at a small-scale frog farm in TBD Nakhon Pathom, and fishery activities at the Por of Bangsean Beach.
	They've also delved into the world of aquaculture, with visits to mussel aquacultur at the Faculty of Fishery, Kasetsart University, Sriracha, and marine ornamental fis production at the same institution. Their educational adventure extends to the Buraph Institute of Marine Science, where they were introduced to aquarium and aquaculture including basic Aquatic Life Support Systems (ALSS).
